

Unless otherwise excused by the Circuit Mediator, the following shall participate in the mediation session: on behalf of objector-appellants, Joshua R. Furman, Scott A. Kron, J. Darrell Palmer, and George Cochran (by telephone); on behalf of the plaintiff-appellee class, Robert R. Ahdoot, Christopher Ridout and Rosemary M. Rivas; on behalf of the defendant-appellee, Christopher Chorba. Any counsel other than those listed above who would like to participate in the mediation shall contact the Circuit Mediator in advance of the mediation. All participants listed above shall come to the mediation session with full authority from their respective clients to settle the disputes on appeal and be prepared to spend the entire day engaged in meaningful settlement discussions.
