

**ORDER GRANTING JOINT  
MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF:  
(1) WITHDRAWAL OF DAVIS  
OBJECTION, AND  
(2) AGREEMENT ALLOCATING  
OBJECTOR ATTORNEYS' FEES  
AND INCENTIVE AWARD**

1           Having considered the Joint Motion Re: Withdrawal of Objection and  
2 Agreement on Objector's Attorneys' Fees and Incentive Award to Objector, and  
3  
4 finding good cause therefor, the Court **GRANTS** the Joint Motion. Accordingly, **IT**  
5 **IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

- 6           1.     The proposed withdrawal of the Davis objection is approved. The  
7                   central concerns Davis raised have been met by the subsequent  
8                   amendment to the settlement.
- 9  
10           2.     The Court approves the negotiated allocation of \$345,000 for fees and  
11                   expenses to Davis's counsel, C. Benjamin Nutley, and for an incentive  
12                   award to Davis. The services performed by Davis and his counsel  
13                   provided a substantial benefit to the Class, justifying the payment of  
14                   attorneys' fees and an incentive award. The payment shall be taken  
15                   from the fee awarded to Class Counsel in this case, and shall be paid  
16                   over within five days of Class Counsel's receipt of their own fee. The  
17                   payment shall be divided as follows: \$342,500 as fees and expenses,  
18                   payable to Mr. Nutley, and \$2,500 as an incentive payment, payable to  
19                   Mr. Davis.
